Dan - Nothing new with regards to the principal selection committee for the elementary.

Pete - It might be time for Ericka and Geneva to send out a document regarding what parents would like to see as far as the timeline or principal selection.

Geneva - Can you refresh us on the process.

Pete - Once the pool is finalized they will start reviewing all openings across the district and they will start matching candidates to schools. They will ultimately produce several candidates. There is a long vetting process and we can't do much until the pool is solidified. We're looking at Jan or Feb.

Dan - I am willing to do all of the hiring this spring but it really should involve the new principal.

Neither Hillary or Dan will be remaining in their current positions, next year.

Pete - They will do three things in the vetting process: are they in the pool, do they fit the bill, and are they interested in our school.

Pete - We'll know more in Jan once the finals are done, SQR is finished, etc. Business as usual until then.

Committee looked at the data for elementary literacy. Numbers of proficient students is steadily rising.

The first grade is struggling but a lot of intense interventions have been put in place to meet those needs. During conferences, parents were asked to help their students practice. First grade is currently making the most progress. One of the greatest difficulties is in regards to staffing.

Tony - I am really interested to see what happens over the next month.

Dan - We're really hoping to see a drop in the tier 3 numbers.

Andrew - What kind of outreach is there for ECE parents to encourage them to enroll their students

Hillary - We used to have a Kindergarten preparedness day and we provided parents with resources, but due to staffing changes we have not been able to do that.

Pete - The data for secondary is posted in my office. We are currently fully staffed. The next round of data will be collected over the next two weeks.

Pete - Geneva do you want to be part of the focus group for SQR? It will be a conference call at six tomorrow night. Look for some information from Aurora, including a conference code, etc. We will send that out in the morning.

Geneva - When is the next work on the UIP

Pete - The next work will most likely take place in March. It will look very similar because we are still working toward those same goals, such as 75% proficient in literacy. It will continue to focus on how are we continuing to work with teachers, professional development, etc.

Ericka - Why are we not continuing to push ECE

Andrew - Because we have to pay for it.

Pete - No, it is now free. The bigger issue is that we don't have space.
